BOARD NOTES


The Alumni Board of Trustees voted on and passed the following issues on April 23, 1975, and all Alumni, Faculty, and Friends are invited to submit applications for:

Rick Sherman, June '73, and his wife Patti (Maskow, June '74) are on their way to Alaska this July where he will be stationed with the Air Force.


Attending John Carroll University where he is majoring in Marketing is June '73 graduate Andrew Szeltner.
