This summer, we added many names and addresses to our mailing list, bringing it well over the 10,000 mark.



The June '75 class of John Marshall spells out true Marshall spirit - UNITY - at its commencement exercises in the JM stadium last June 6th. Class size was 777.


... SCHOLARSHIPS
