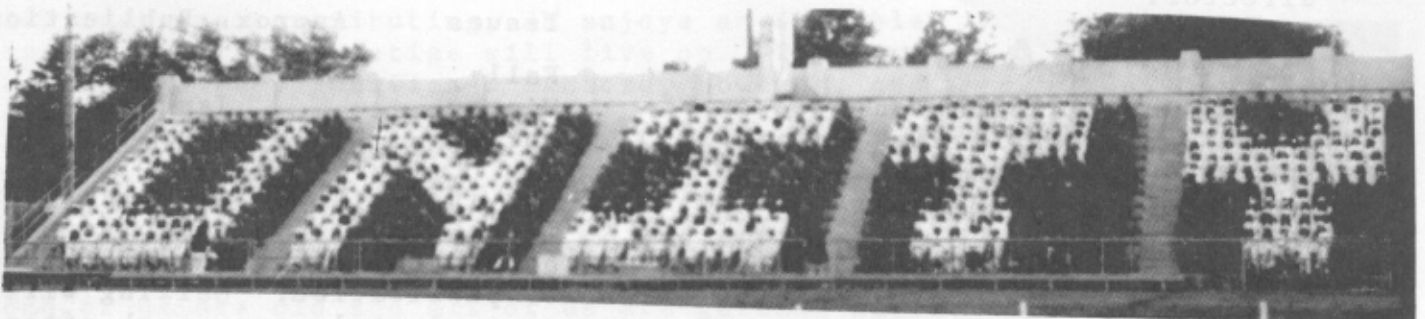

The June '75 class of John Marshall spells out true Marshall spirit - UNITY - at its commencement exercises in the JM stadium last June 6th. Class size was 777.

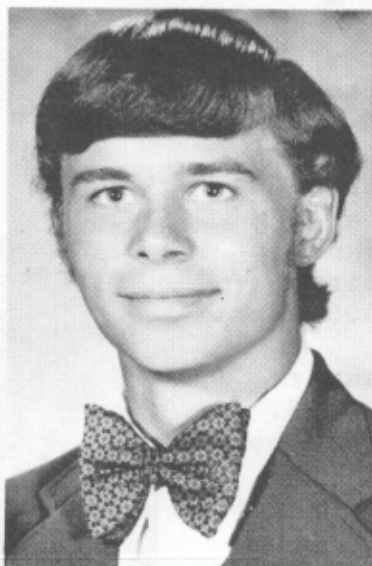
...SCHOLARSHIPS

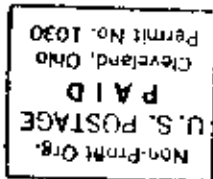
