ALUMNI AWARD

Roxane Mackey has been selected to receive the 1976 Alumni Association Memorial Scholarship award. She has been on either the honor or merit roll during her six semesters at John Marshall.

Accepted at Ohio State University, she plans to continue her education in music. She has been a member of both the band and orchestra for three years, a member of the All-City Band and Orchestra, the Ohio State Fair Girls Band, and the All-State Bicentennial Band.

While at JMH, Roxane was a home-room representative to Student Council, Girls' Gym Leader, and Teacher's Aide.

She was chosen by the Alumni Board of Trustees from many outstanding nominations made by faculty and staff.

This year's award carries a \$100 scholarship which was given in memory of Howard Gaub, former Industrial Arts Instructor.

To be eligible for the award, the nominee must have between a 2.5 and 3.5 grade point average, no failing marks, and must be active in many areas of service at John Marshall.

Our recipient, shown in the photograph receiving her award from Marshall principal Joseph Dinunzio, will make a fine representative of John Marshall.



ALUMNI DRIVE TOPS \$5,600

The 1976 Alumni Drive exceeded its goal of \$4,000 by 40 per cent. As of September 1st, we have received \$5,628.40 from 837 donors. The average donation figured out to be \$6.72. Many people gave more, some gave less. The important thing is that our people cared to give something.

"Response from our Alumni, Faculty, and Friends was just great," stated Paul Gruber, Alumni Director. "We were just hoping to raise \$4,000 to meet our operational expenses, but the response was superior."

This brings the total contributed for our four years to \$14,256.32. Expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1976 were \$9,973.75 and are continuing upward. It now costs the Alumni Association two cents per newsletter mailed when the old rate was 1.8 cents. Address corrections to update our mailing list went from ten cents to 25 cents each. When you put out 12,000 letters and receive 300 corrections, this adds up!

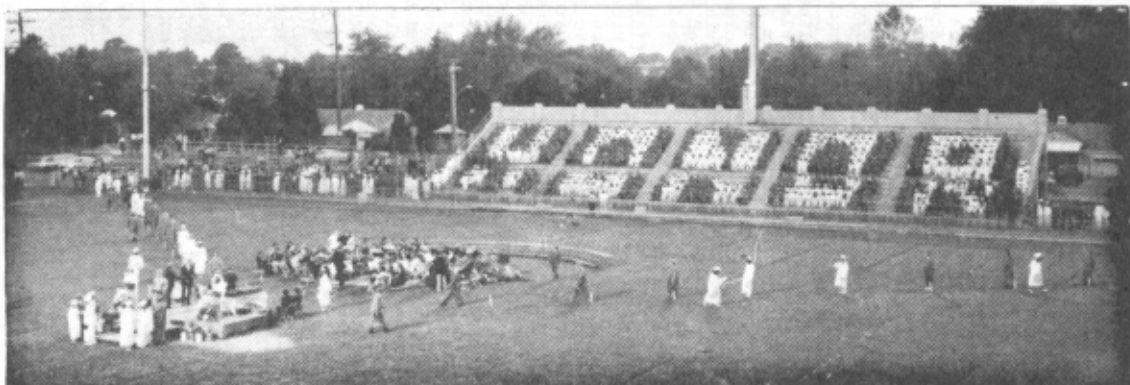
