

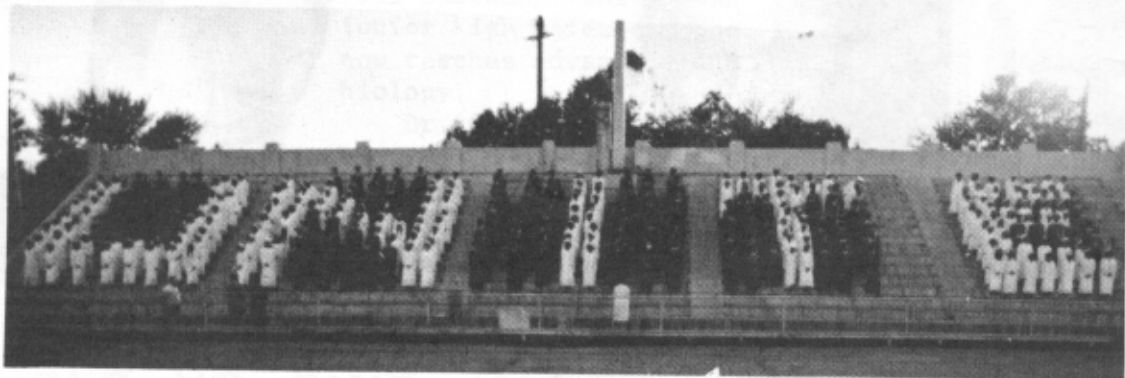

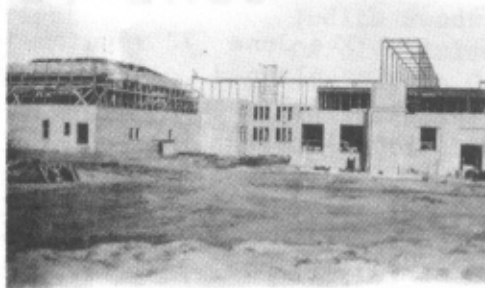
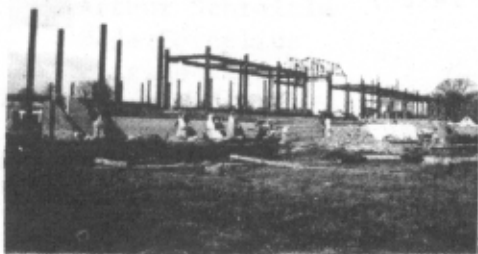


GRADUATES

Both ladies oversee alumni staff operations. Mrs. Laux was also nominated to the Executive Committee which controls Association expenses.



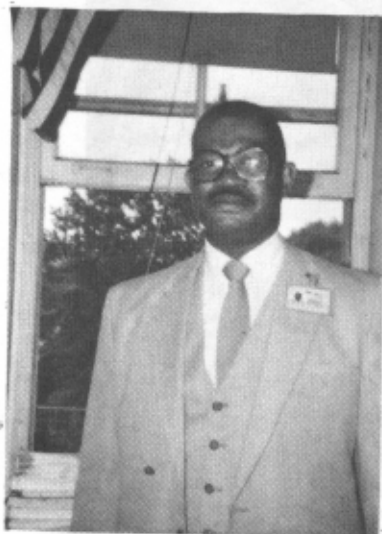
DOCTOR IN THE HOUSE
