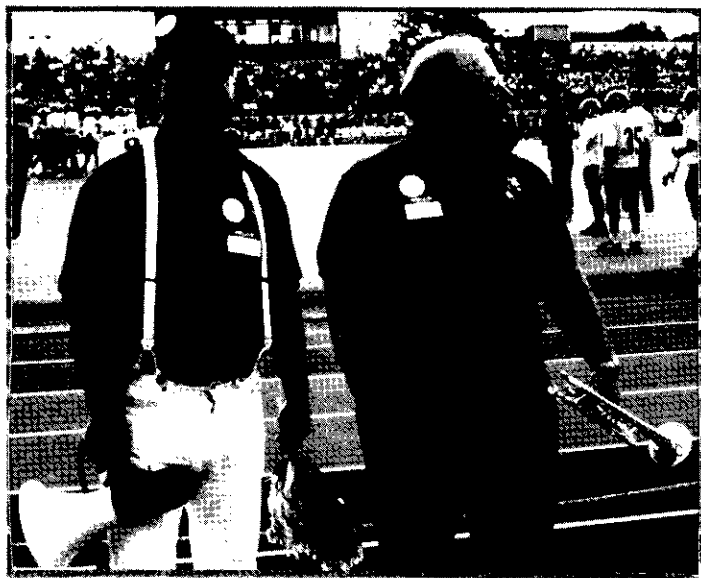

JMH Today

Many of you wrote and told us that you would like more information about what John Marshall is like today. On January 29th, I had the opportunity to interview Principal Gilbert Freilino about the current status of the school.

Today, John Marshall has 2,032 students in grades 9 through 12. This is an increase of over 700 students, due to the closing of West Tech. Last June the graduating class had 195 students. Ninety-eight percent of the senior class passed all four parts of the state proficiency test. Last year, Marshall students received more than one million dollars in scholarship and grant money.

Demographically, the current enrollment is approximately 50% Caucasian and 50% African-American, Hispanic and Oriental. Most students are from the West Park or West Tech area. Eight busloads of students are transported daily from the John F. Kennedy neighborhood on Cleveland's southeast side.

John Marshall has an eight period day that begins at 7:30 A.M. and ends at 2:15 P.M, Monday through Friday. Many of the clubs and other activities that we enjoyed are still active, including football, basketball, baseball, volleyball, and softball. Unfortunately, the marching band no longer exists.

The building that we all remember remains in fairly good condition, thanks to a recent paint job of all the school corridors.

Many of you will be happy to know that in spite of some discipline and financial problems, John Marshall is one of the success stories of the Cleveland Public Schools.

Enrollment had dropped in recent years and the board could no longer justify keeping the school open. As a result, their faculty and students have been absorbed by Marshall and Rhodes. Our hats are off to our friends from West Tech, and we hope that their tradition and pride will long be remembered by their alumni.

Faculty News

Dorothy Winovich came to Marshall in the fall of 1959 and was a Physical Education teacher until June 1973. She then took a leave of absence to complete her Masters Degree in Counseling. She returned to the Cleveland Schools in the fall of 1974 and was assigned to Thomas Jefferson Junior High for five years, Lincoln-West for two years, and Nathan Hale for most of the 81-82 school year. She was then transferred back to John Marshall in the spring of 1982 and retired from full-time duties in 1990. She has continued to do substitute counseling in Cleveland since that time. She and Nancy (Falkner) Stasek started an organization of women who taught at Marshall or were students at Marshall and later became teachers in the Cleveland area. Their number is now over 100. She still lives in Westlake and remains active in many civic and educational endeavors.

June Eddingfield received her Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Classic Languages from Indiana University (Phi Beta Kappa). She taught for 14 years in Indiana before coming to Marshall in September, 1923. She retired in 1956 and with a few minor exceptions, was essentially Marshall's only Latin Teacher. Her love of teaching and dedication to students is remembered by all. She was always fond of poetry and was a member of the Ohio Poetry Society. She was a prolific letter writer and was in lifelong touch with many friends and students up to the time of her death in 1982, at the age of 95. As a condition of her will, in 1982, a book of poems was published as her only monument, including:

A TEACHER'S PRAYER

The day is brief and there is much to do
Help me to know which things are most worthwhile
To every pupil's need may I be true;
There will be problems--may I keep a smile.

Perhaps I've done the most when I had thought
I did the least. How can a teacher know
When something said has stirred a sleeping mind
And like a seed, takes root, begins to grow?

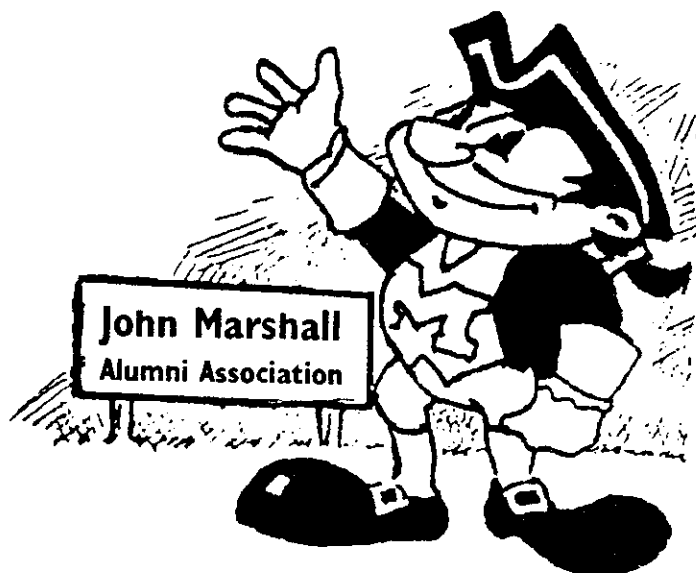
