We have not lost your address—there simply hasn't been a newsletter published for two years. During the 1989-90 school year, there was little concern or support by administrators for an alumni association and, when I retired in June, 1990, I lost access to the students who folded, coalated, stapled and applied the labels to 17,500 newsletters.

The Alumni Association must now begin to take the steps necessary for the future. The new principal, Mr. Gilbert Freilino, has a sense of committment to the school that has not been seen in several years and his support will definitely make things easier. The Association can no longer function as a one-man operation. Over the years many of you have expressed interest in helping. I know that interest remains and now it must be transformed into action. Some of the areas that need your help are: **Reunion coordinator**: working with individual reunion committees including publicity, mailings, address updates. **Archives**: A great deal of information and material has been accumulated in the last five years, and a great deal more needs to be obtained; it needs to be carefully preserved, (a microfilm project may be in order for "Terps"), - most importantly it needs to be displayed, cared for, used and appreciated. How about a History of John Marshall/West Park? Video tape projects? **Newsletter**: The biggest job is that of putting the newsletter together. Perhaps there could be section editors to handle class notes or current school news. **Finance**: Treasurer, fund raiser, scholarships. **Secretary**: Someone to handle the phone calls, channel information in the right direction, and keep up with the address changes. **Constitution**: this may need to be restructured to accomodate the direction that the alumni association will take in the future. And finally, someone to oversee the entire operation.
